### Additional Information

- This agreement permits students successfully completing the Basic Recruit Academy at any WTCS institution to transfer these credits to UWSP, at the student's option, for the College of Natural Resources Conservation Law Enforcement major or Conservation Law Enforcement minor programs, or for the College of Letters and Science Criminal Justice minor.

- This program-to-program agreement will allow a student who has successfully completed the Criminal Justice – Law Enforcement 720 Academy to transfer 15 credits to UW-Stevens Point, at the student's option, as either NRES 393 or SOC 393, but not both. A grade of "P" (Pass) will be recorded on the UWSP transcript.
- None of the credits transferred under this agreement will apply toward UW-Stevens Point's Forty Credit Rule which requires a student to earn at least 40 credits in courses numbered 300 or above.
- The transferred credits may only be applied toward the Conservation Law Enforcement major, the Conservation Law Enforcement minor, or the Criminal Justice minor. If after transfer credit has been awarded at UWSP a student subsequently changes his/her declared major or minor from one of these approved programs, the credits will not apply toward a degree and will be removed from the student's UW-Stevens Point record.
