## Additional Information

- **CRIMLJUS 2230 criminal justice major requirement fulfilled if AAS degree is completed OR the Probation & Parole and Intro to Corrections courses are completed.**
- If Basic Anatomy is taken, one of the two Natural Science required classes is fulfilled. Remaining course taken at UW-Platteville will need to be in a discipline other than Biology.
- If Introduction to Diversity Studies is taken, Ethnic & Women and Gender Studies requirement is met.
- **If Introduction to Sociology and Intro to Psychology and/or Developmental Psychology are taken, the Social Science general education requirement is met.**
