- The student must have completed Mid-State courses within the last five years of being admitted to Viterbo University.
- The maximum number of credits a student can transfer into Viterbo University is 90 credits.
- In order to enter student teaching, the student must have earned a cumulative GPA of 2.75 or higher at Viterbo.
- In order to be endorsed for licensure upon completion of the degree requirements, the student must earn a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher at Viterbo.
