- Students must complete the entire Associate of Applied Science - Nursing with a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or above.

- Students may transfer up to 90 credits that will be applied toward a Lakeland University Bachelor of Science degree.
- A minimum of 30 credits of college credit must be earned to Lakeland University to confer the BSN degree.
