### Additional Information

- Upon admission to Pre-Nursing at UWSP, students will declare their intent to enroll in the Partnership Program (1 + 2 + 1).
- Mid-State ADN Entry Criteria: The following courses/requirements must be completed, or be in-progress\*, to be invited to Mid-State onboarding. \*In progress is defined as:
  - If a student is entering the RN program in the following fall: The current fall, future winterim, future spring can be in progress at the time of application. Future summer cannot count for in-progress.
  - If a student is entering the RN program in the following spring: The current spring, future summer, and future fall can be in progress at the time of application. Future winterim cannot count for in-progress.
- Additional Admission Requirements
  - Math requirements prior to application or in progress are as follows:
    - Math ACT 18 within the last five years or
    - Next Generation Accuplacer 259 within the last five years or
    - TABE Level D score of 596 or
    - Mid-State College Mathematics (10804107) or Mid-State Introductory Statistics (10804189) with "C" or better, or equivalent transfer credit
    - UWSP MATH 90 and/or UWSP MATH 95 either alone or combined does not meet the Nursing Math requirement.
    - If a student has completed UWSP MATH 90 and/or UWSP MATH 95, they are prepared to progress into either Mid-State College Mathematics (10804107) or Mid State Introductory Statistics (10804189).

- If a student has completed both UWSP MATH 95 and UWSP MATH 107 these courses combined transfer as Mid-State Intermediate Algebra with Applications (10804118), satisfying the Nursing Math requirement.
- Nursing Assistant course with a grade of C or better; or on the Wisconsin State Registry for Certified Nurse Assistant; or by receiving Nursing Assistant credit for prior learning according to policy and procedures on Mid-State's [website](#).
- College-level courses each with a grade of "C" or better:
  - Must be completed at time of application: One of the courses in the paired Anatomy & Physiology I (BIOL 285) and Anatomy & Physiology II (BIOL 286); or Human Physiology (BIOL 385) and Human Anatomy (BIOL 387); or General Anatomy & Physiology (10806177) and Advanced Anatomy & Physiology (10806179); or equivalent. \*NOTE: UWSP BIOL 287 Essentials of Human Anatomy does not satisfy requirements.
  - May be in progress at the time of application:
    - English Composition
    - Developmental Psychology
    - Anatomy & Physiology II (BIO 286), Human Anatomy (BIOL 387), Advanced Anatomy & Physiology (10806179)
  - Final grade of C or better will be verified and is necessary to start Nursing coursework for any in progress coursework at the time of application.
- To earn a Bachelor's degree from UWSP, the student must earn a minimum of 120 credits and must obtain a Wisconsin Registered Nurse License.
