

MID-STATE TECHNICAL COLLEGE ASSOCIATE OF ARTS TO EDGEWOOD COLLEGE TRANSFER GUIDE

Students who receive an Associate of Arts degree from Mid-State Technical College will be guaranteed admission to Edgewood College when students transfer directly from Mid-State to Edgewood College within five years of completing their Associate degree.

Additional Information

- Students who take coursework at another institution between the completion of their coursework at Mid-State and their transfer to Edgewood College must also meet Edgewood College's transfer student admissions requirements of a cumulative GPA of 2.0 in all college-level coursework. Students must also meet posted admission deadlines.
- A maximum of 72 credits may be transferred from all combined coursework earned at Mid-State Technical College. Only courses passed with a grade of C- or better will be accepted for transfer credit.
- Students who receive an Associate of Arts degree from Mid-State Technical College will be considered to have fulfilled all of Edgewood College's General Education requirements except the COR courses (COR 199, COR 2, and COR 3).
- The students must earn the general residency requirement of a minimum of 32 semester credits at Edgewood College, including required work in the major. Each academic department or school will determine the acceptability of transfer courses to the major or minor and the number of Edgewood College credits that must be earned in the major or minor.
