



Advanced Placement (AP) Exam List

Advanced Placement (AP) is a high school academic program with courses in more than 30 subjects that culminate with college-level assessments. AP Exams test students' ability to perform at a college level. Exams are graded on a scale of 1 to 5, with a score of 3 or higher considered successful and eligible for credit at Mid-State.

Mid-State will award credit by examination for the AP courses below. Students must meet or exceed the minimum score. Official AP test score transcripts need to be sent from College Board directly to Mid-State. Credit is awarded when you are admitted into a program at Mid-State.
